



Sources for plants and seeds native to Northeast Ohio

Three notes of importance in purchasing plants for your garden:

Please try to be sure that the source where you purchase your native plants has not treated those plants with an insecticide such as a neonicotinoid, which is lethal to pollinators that attempt to pollinate the plant. Ask at the nursery; if they cannot assure you, then buy from someone else. Nurseries need to know that this makes a difference to their customers.

Please do not sow seeds that have been coated with neonicotinoids; just one such seed will kill any bird that eats it. <https://abcbirds.org/neonics>

It is always best to plant specimens that have been grown from local phenotypes – that is, descended from plants that originally grew as close to your vicinity as possible. You may wish to take this into account when sourcing plants.

Many local nature organizations coordinate plant sales throughout the spring and summer. A simple internet search for local plant sales in your area will likely point you to them.
